TAKE NOTE!

Show the Lord that you are ready to receive and to act on revelation by focusing on listening to the Spirit and writing down what you think and feel. Don't worry about writing down every little thing that is said. You can always go back and read or watch these talks later.

"There is a great analogy [for note-taking] in the Book of Mormon. There are the large plates, which are the history of the people, and the small plates, which are the revelations and the sacred writings. If a person listening to a talk . . . is jotting down what the person is saying, then you are recording on the large plates—the history of the meeting. If you are recording the individual impressions that are coming to you by the Holy Ghost, you are creating your own small plates."
