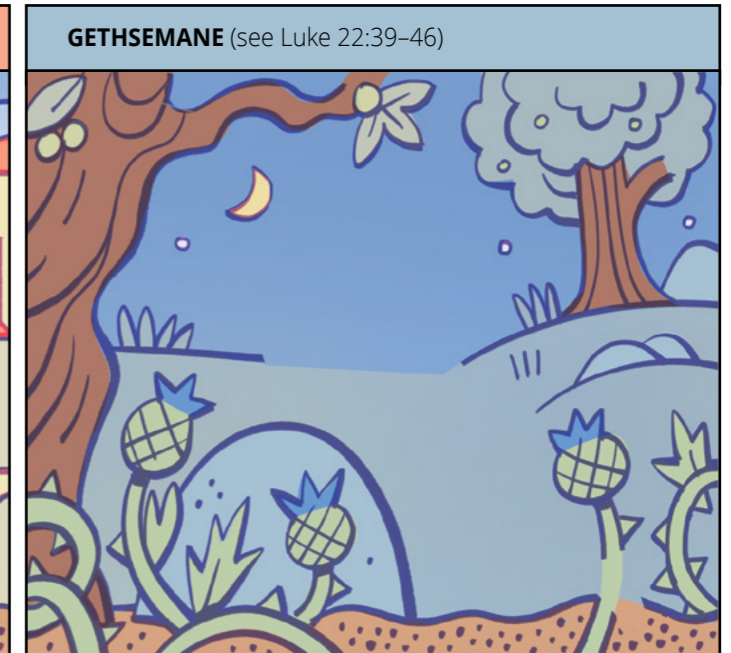
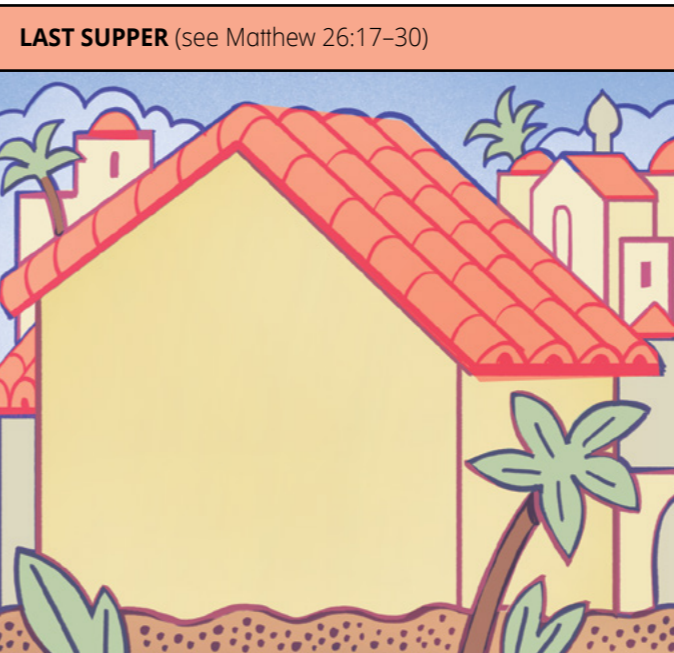

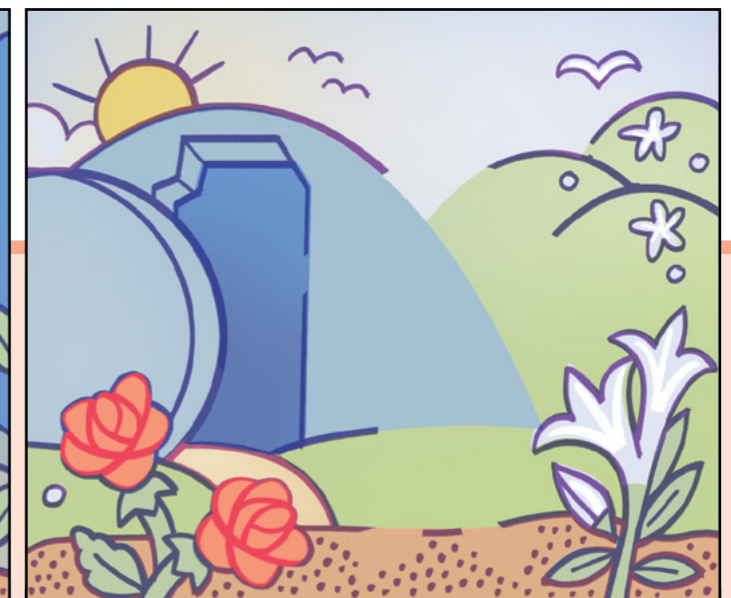


## FLASHLIGHT STORIES

## COUNTING LOAVES AND FISHES

The Savior once fed 4,000 people with seven loaves of bread and a few fish (see Matthew 15:32-39). Can you figure out the answer to this loaves and fishes math equation?

$$\begin{aligned}
