## The Foolish Virgins

- 1. Discuss the following questions together:
  - What might the lamps and oil represent in the parable? (You could review Doctrine and Covenants 45:56–57 and the statement by President Russell M. Nelson in section 2 of the preparation material.)
  - What might be significant about the phrases "while the bridegroom tarried" (Matthew 25:5) and "at midnight there was a cry made" (verse 6)?
  - Why were five of the virgins described as foolish? (You could discuss what the phrases "I know you not" [verse 12] and "Ye know me not" (Joseph Smith Translation, Matthew 25:11 [in Matthew 25:12, footnote a]) teach us about these virgins' preparation.)
- 2. Identify one or two common examples of how we as members of the Church might choose to be like the foolish virgins. Be prepared to share your examples with a group who discussed the wise virgins.
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
