

Priests and Levites were prominent religious figures in Jewish tradition.

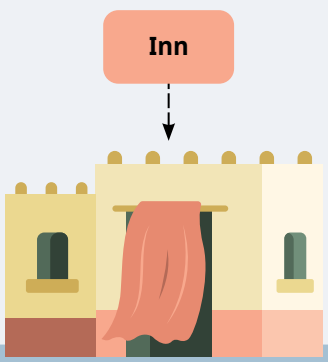
Samaritans were viewed by Jews as enemies because their religion and culture were different.

The Samaritan brought the man to an inn to take care of him.

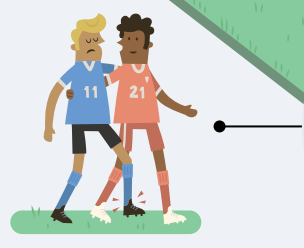
Both the priest and the Levite passed by on the other side of the road.
