Sara B. eats *tomtegröt* (Santa's porridge), **9. LUSSEBULLAR**, and **10. PEPPARKAKOR**.



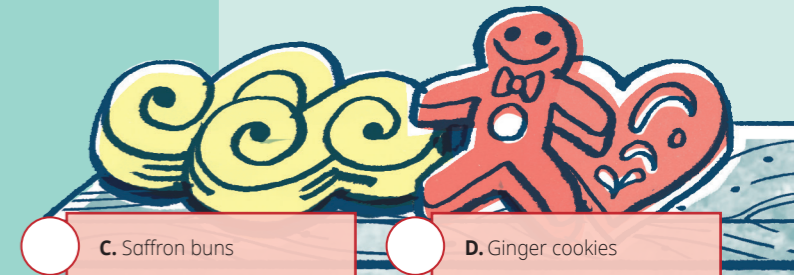

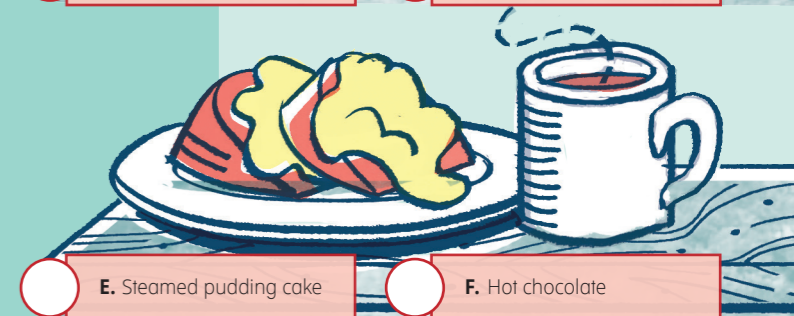

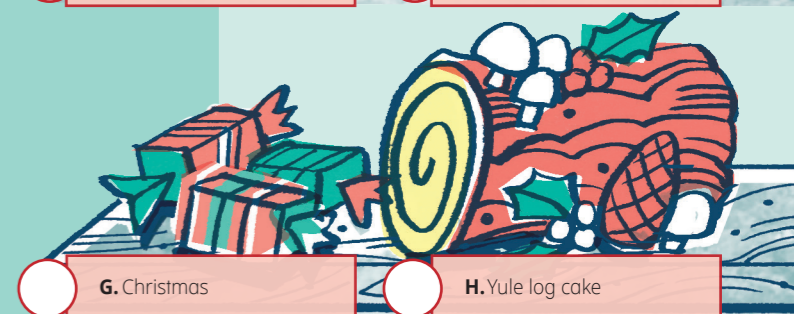

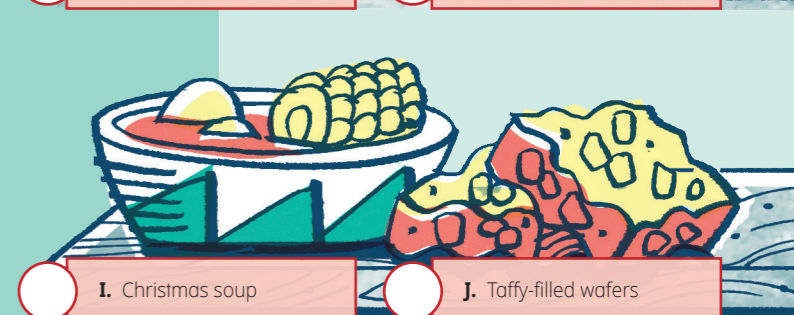

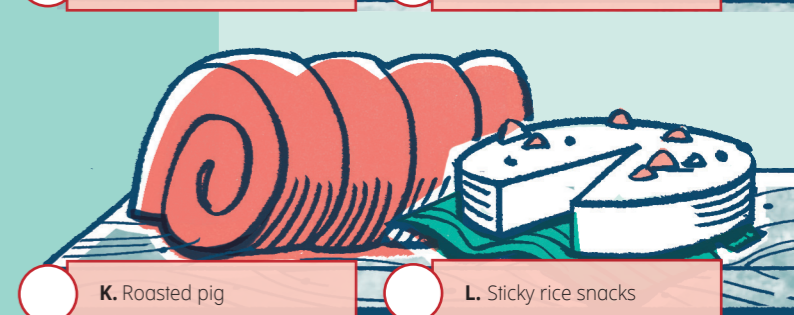
