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Coming unto Christ and Changing Our Lives

Change can be scary. But as Elder Hallstrom taught, it is both required and expected in order for us to come unto Christ. Ponder these questions as you consider changes you might make with the Savior’s help:

- Are there things I know I ought to change but don’t want to change? Why?
- When was the last time I was reading the scriptures, praying, or listening in church and had the thought suddenly come to me that I ought to change something? What did I do about it?
- What are some examples from the scriptures of people who made the kinds of changes I would like to make? How did they do it?
- Are there changes I think are impossible that really are possible with the Savior’s help?

As you think about what has kept you from making changes, set small goals to help you overcome them so you can become the person you and Heavenly Father know you can become.

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
