## NOVEMBER

- 30 Freely Give**  
Jesus gave to others. Give a smile, a treat, one of your toys, or a service to someone.

## DECEMBER

- 1 Let Your Love Shine**  
Jesus shared His love with others. Write down or draw three things you love about each person in your family. Hang the lists for your family to see.
- 2 Wise Man's Gift**  
How has a wise man or woman blessed you? Thank them for their help.
- 3 The Christ Child**  
Jesus's birth showed God's love for all of us. Watch the short online video *The Christ Child* with your family, and talk about how you feel God's love.
- 4 Love Thy Neighbor**  
Jesus taught us to love the people around us. With your family, visit a neighbor and get to know them better.
- 5 Fast Relief**  
Fast as Jesus did. If you are able, go without a meal or two and have your family donate the money from those meals to charity. Talk to a loved one about how fasting like Jesus can strengthen us and others.
- 6 Magic Memory**  
Think about a favorite Christmas memory that helped you remember Jesus. Draw a picture of it or find a photo of it. Share the picture with your family. Tell them why that memory is special to you.
- 7 Health Caring**  
Jesus cared for others. Thank someone who has cared for you this year.

- 8 Full Attention**  
Jesus listened to people when they talked. When people talk with you today, try to look at them in the eyes.
- 9 Light the Family Tree**  
Honor your family members who lived before you were born. Learn something new about someone from your family history.
- 10 Showtime**  
Jesus included others. Find someone at school who is alone or needs a friend. Invite him or her to join your family for a Christmas concert, play, or other event.
- 11 Recipe for Rejoicing**  
Jesus talked with many people while eating with them. As you eat today, learn something new about each person you eat with.
- 12 Save a Seat**  
Invite a friend or family member to attend Church with you to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ.
- 13 The Gift of Prayer**  
Jesus prayed to His Father. Kneel and pray to Heavenly Father each morning and night.
- 14 Season's Greetings**  
Jesus was a friend to everyone. Say hi to someone new to help them feel loved.
- 15 Shining Star**  
A new star came to light the world when Jesus was born. Who is a light to you? Draw a Christmas tree to give them, and put their name on a star at the top.
- 16 Christmas Dinners**  
Just like Jesus, you can feed the hungry. As a family, deliver food to someone in need.
- 17 Secret Shepherd**  
Shepherds visited Jesus when He was born. Shepherds guide their sheep and keep them safe. Thank someone who, like shepherds, has helped guide you to Jesus.

- 18 Songs Worth Sharing**  
Jesus and His followers sang hymns. Gather with your friends or loved ones to sing songs about Jesus. You can even call others on the phone to sing to them.
- 19 From Luke 2 You**  
Take turns reading with others about Jesus's birth in Luke 2:1–20. You could even take turns with family or friends over the phone.
- 20 Together Time**  
Jesus gathered people together to teach and serve them. Help your family gather for an in-person activity or in a video chat with family who live far away.
- 21 Sharing Light**  
Jesus taught through stories. Share with someone a story from your life that is special to you. Ask others to do the same.
- 22 Gifts from God**  
You can give thanks as Jesus did. Think about the gifts God has given you, and write them down or draw a picture of them.
- 23 Treats Times Two**  
Share as Jesus did. Make or buy two treats. Give one to a friend, then ask them who you can give the second treat to.
- 24 Love Mom and Dad**  
Honor your parents as Jesus did. Write your parents (or a parental figure) a note or card with things you love about them.
- 25 Jesus Is the Light of the World**  
Christmas is a time to honor Jesus Christ. Share a scripture with someone about Him.
- 26 Light 2022**  
We can focus on Jesus all year long. As you set Children and Youth goals for 2022, notice how Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ can help you with your goals each day. In your *Children's Guidebook*, write down ways They bless you.
